## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Our water system violated a drinking water reporting requirement the past year. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 1/1/2020 to 12/31/2022, we did monitor for the required parameters but submitted the data to the state after the due date due to laboratory late response.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the monitoring we did not conduct, how often we are supposed to sample and how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took and when the samples should have been taken.
